Meeting Minutes

The meeting minutes, for the 7 November 2019 meeting, were reviewed and corrections made. A motion by Woody Isaacs to accept the minutes as corrected was seconded by Beverly Rossetto. Motion Carried.

Treasurers Report

- The Treasurer's report was reviewed. The General fund started 1 November at \$48,840.84, added interest of \$10.72, voided check of \$87.50, and old fuel tank sale of \$100 with expenses of \$4,710.30 had an ending balance of \$44,328.74. December added interest of \$10.96, a donation of \$50 and after expenses of \$843.23 ended with a final balance of \$43,546.47.
- The equipment fund is made up of a savings fund and three CDs. They started 1 November at \$67,159.37 and earned interest of \$127.22 for an ending balance of \$67,286.59. December added \$123.63 in interest for a final balance of \$67,410.21.

Medical Coordinator's Report

- Medical Coordinator's reported seven total runs in the last two months of which six were medical and one was an accident. Four were transported to the hospital. Rogers City responded to five calls and Onaway responded to two calls. Bearinger had three calls and Ocqueoc had four calls.
- The ambulance for first responders is set up and read to be used. The back step/bumper needs repair. Extensive work was done on the door hinges to get the doors back in operation.
- Beverly Rossetto drove to Jackson, Michigan and picked up a cot for the unit and will not accept mileage reimbursement. Mr. John Worden paid for the cot and donated it to the department. Thanks to John Worden, *Tom Anglin*, and Beverly Rossetto for helping the department get a cot for the new unit was expressed by several people.

Old Business

• Hilger Case Status. The secretary contacted Mr. Vogler's office and was told a letter was sent to Mr. Hilger's attorney about the non-payment.

New Business

- The preliminary Department budget was presented and Beverly Rossetto went thru each line of the budget pointing out the increases and decreases. She noted the contribution from the units is an estimate as the amount is based on an approved budget amount before any roll over from the prior year budget. There was some confusion concerning the totals until it was pointed out that the \$10,000 transferred to the Equipment fund did not show up as an expense in the 2019-2020 budget numbers because of the software. Adding the amount back in showed a 2019-2020 budget of \$107,294.87 and a proposed 2020-2021 budget of \$102,600.00 which is a decrease of \$4,694.87. A motion to approve the budget as presented was made by Archie Patterson and seconded by Woody Isaacs. Motion Carried. The budget will be presented to each of the Townships at their next meeting and approved at the Tri-Board meeting in March.
- Next year's budget will cover the installation costs for two mobile radios that were donated by Motorola.

• Irvin Dedow asked the status of the building as an approved shelter. It was explained that the Red Cross only provides training on-line and without an onsite training the organization and responsibilities to operate the building as an over flow shelter could not be determined.

<u>Fire Chiefs Report:</u> The Fire Chiefs report is attached. It covers the period of 1 Jul to 31 Aug 2021. There were two total runs, one false alarm and one non-fire highway cleanup on US 23. Parking lot repairs were completed successfully. Gary asked if there was an update from the insurance company regarding damage at the refuge harbor dry hydrant; Beverly is still waiting on an update, initial estimates are \$3-5k to repair.

Assistant Fire Chiefs Report: Training was completed at the Rainey River dry hydrant, marginally successful overall. The crew had difficulty in flushing the hydrant and did not make any significant progress in clearing it from shore. Currently attempting to get a diver to inspect the underwater inlet for obstructions. There is a new funding opportunity within the county to provide training at Alpena Community College. The training will be certificate based and managed by ACC, they are currently providing this program to Alpena County and Presque Isle County would be an addition to the existing.

<u>Medical Coordinators Report:</u> The Medical Coordinators report is attached. Anna Beach reports a total of 13 Calls in Jul and Aug. A bumper was lost on the ambulance during a call down a rough road, the bumper will need to be replaced prior to the upcoming state inspection. Current estimate is \$4k to repair. Need to check with insurance company to see if the damage is covered under our policy.
