Plans must be submitted with an application for Plan Examination and the appropriate deposit before a permit can be issued, except as listed below. Plans are not required for the following:

1. on and two family dwelling containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
 2. Alterations and repair work determined by the **plumbing** official to be of a minor nature.
 3. Buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12
 4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00
- If work being performed is described above, check box below "plans Not Required".

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

VI. Homeowner Affidavit

VIIa. Fee Clarification

Item #2 Mobile Home Unit Site: When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. When setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

Item #3, Fixtures, Floor Drains, Special Drains, and Water Connected Appliances included: see drop down list
Plus any other fixture, drain or water connected appliance not specifically listed

Item #25, Domestic water treatment and filtering equipment: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

IX. Instructions for completing application

VALIDATION AREA

General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the applicaiton for permit has been filed with the Bureau of Construction Codes and Fire Safety. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. No work shall be conceled until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be proved on the permit form. When ready for an inspeciton, call the inspector providing as **much** advanc notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. C.OSEED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.

Where to submit application: The bureau of construction codes and fire safety is responsible for code enforcement in units of government throughout the state which have no local program and for all state owned buildings. Permit applications for state issued permits should be sent to the address on the front of this applicaiton. If you are not sure whether a state permit or a local permit is appropriate, contact our office or our local building inspector. Questions regarding state issued permits may be directed to the office of Management Services, Permit Section at 517 241 9313. Code questions may be directed to the Plumbing Division at 517 241 9330.
